## Tenure Track Junior Faculty Position Theoretical Condensed Matter Physics

The Faculty of Physics invites applications of outstanding young scientists whose research profile and interest promise close future ties with the ongoing FWF sponsored interdisciplinary special research program “Vienna Computational Material Science Laboratory” ([www.sfb-vicom.at](http://www.sfb-vicom.at)). The applicant is expected to have a Ph.D. in theoretical physics or a closely related field, a few years of post-doctoral experience, and an excellent research record that indicates a high potential for a future successful career in academia.

The initial probationary tenure track appointment will be made on the “Universitätsassistent” (equivalent to an assistant professor) level for up to 6 years. After a successful tenure evaluation, the promotion to a permanent associate professorship is possible.

The Vienna University of Technology is committed to increase female employment in leading scientist positions. Qualified female applicants are expressly encouraged to apply and will be given preference when equally qualified. Handicapped persons with appropriate qualifications are expressly encouraged to apply.
